

## 4-H Dog Demonstration

Show Time is 1:00pm - Monday, October 10, 2016

All entries to be sent to the 4-H Educator, PO BOX 1480, Conway, NH 03818 and be postmarked by **September 15, 2016** on the 4-H Entry Form.

### Show Requirements:

1. Open to all 4-H members in Carroll County who are enrolled in the 4-H Dog Care and Training Project, including having submitted Intent to Show forms for their project animal with their county extension office prior to May 1, 2016. Intent to Show Form must accompany the member to the show.
2. 4-H dogs may be crossbred or purebred, and must be at least 6 months of age at the time of the show.
3. 4-H members are responsible for all training and grooming associated with their project animal. Members are responsible for ALL care, feeding and safety while on show or event grounds.
4. Females in heat are NOT allowed on 4-H dog show grounds or at any 4-H event.
5. Chain leashes, prong collars, spiked collars, electric collars and harness are not allowed on show grounds or any 4-H dog event.
6. All New Hampshire 4-H dog rules apply at all 4-H Dog Show, Demonstrations and events and can be found in the New Hampshire Guide to 4-H Dog Show (<http://extension.unh.edu/4-H-Animal-and-Ag-Science/4-H-Dog-Page>).
7. Health Forms: Every dog at the show must be accompanied by a 4-H Dog Show Health Sheet. This document verifies that the dog has had preventative shots, and is currently inoculated for rabies. Bitches in heat are not allowed at the 4-H Dog show under any circumstances.
8. Member Attire: 4-H members showing are expected to dress in the recommended uniform listed under the 4-H Department Rules.
9. 4-H Department Rules and Regulations will be followed.
10. Members are solely responsible for the care and handling of their dogs at all times.
11. Dogs are not allowed on the fairgrounds, except during the show time. Information on passes, parking, housing, and dog identification bandannas will be mailed after 4-H Entry Forms are received.
